Subhash C. Pandey, Ph.D.



Dr. Pandey received his Ph.D. from the Pharmacology division of the Central Drug Research Institute in Lucknow, India. He is currently Professor of Psychiatry, Anatomy and Cell Biology, and Director of an NIAAA funded Alcohol Research Center at the University of Illinois at Chicago. Dr. Pandey is also a Senior Research Career Scientist at the Jesse Brown VA Medical Center in Chicago. He is well known for his scientific contributions towards molecular and cellular neuroscience of alcohol abuse and anxiety disorders as well as his pioneer work on the epigenetic basis of alcoholism. Dr. Pandey has received various honors and awards; most notably the 2010 Bowles

Lectureship Award in alcoholism research presented by University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He was recognized as a notable biomedical VA researcher in 2014. He is an active member of the Research Society on Alcoholism (RSA), International Society for Biomedical Research on Alcoholism (ISBRA) and several other scientific societies, and a fellow of the Indian Academy of Neurosciences and Collegium Internationale Neuro-psychopharmacologicum (CINP). Dr. Pandey has also been serving as a field editor for "Alcoholism Clinical and Experimental Research" journal. Dr. Pandey has authored many peer reviewed research and review articles and book chapters in the fields of alcohol addiction.
