
## Yan Dong, M.Sc., Ph.D.



Dr. Yan Dong is an Associate Professor of Neuroscience at University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, PA. He received his Ph.D. from the Chicago Medical School with Drs. Francis White and Marina Wolf. He completed his postdoctoral training at Stanford University School of Medicine with Dr. Robert Malenka. He was an Assistant and then Associate Professor at Washington State University 2006 – 2012.
