Dr. Sripada is Associate Professor of Psychiatry and Philosophy at the University of Michigan. His work focuses on the neurodevelopment of cognition and executive control, utilizing large neuroimaging datasets, multivariate analysis methods, and computational modeling. Recent projects have examined how socioeconomic adversity affects neurocognition and the developing brain. He also has interests in measurement issues in cognitive science, including measurement of constructs such as executive control and implicit biases. He is site PI for the Michigan site of the Adolescent Brain Cognitive Development study.
