What is Quality Assurance?

Quality Assurance (QA) is:

- A way of preventing mistakes and avoiding problems when delivering products or services to customers;
- Providing confidence that quality requirements will be fulfilled internally to management and externally to customers.

Importance of Data Accuracy

- Data accuracy is vital to the success of an organization's data management efforts.
- Poor and incomplete data collection, as well as a lack of quality data, can cause an inability to accurately assess performance, leading to wasted dollars and poor decision making.
- Accurate and complete data helps to make better decisions, produce better outputs, and increase efficiencies, as well as lower risks in outcomes.
