

Ashley Smith, Ph.D.



Dr. Smith is a Program Officer in the Developmental Mechanisms and Trajectories of Psychopathology Branch, Division of Translational Research at the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH). Dr. Smith oversees two grant portfolios – 1). a research training grant portfolio at the pre-doctoral and post-doctoral level that supports research that translates knowledge from basic science to discover the etiology, pathophysiology, and trajectory of mental disorders and 2). a research project grant portfolio focused on mechanisms of integrative psychopathology during adolescence. She is a member of the NIMH Training Team and NIMH’s Priorities for Child and Adolescent Research Working Group, among others. Dr. Smith earned her doctorate in Psychology from Temple University (Philadelphia, PA) before completing a postdoctoral fellowship in the Intramural Research Program at NIMH, where she studied mechanisms underlying social experiences in adolescents with anxiety disorders.
