Dr. Kumar Dharmarajan is a cardiologist, geriatrician and Associate Chief Medical Officer at Clover Health, where he leads its clinical programs and R&D initiatives for its most medically complex members. He also serves as Chief Clinician and Governing Body Chair of the Clover Health Partners Direct Contracting Entity. Prior to joining Clover, Dr. Dharmarajan developed quality measures used by Medicare in its national value-based purchasing programs. He also led research studies to help hospitals and health systems lower preventable hospitalizations. His work has appeared in top medical journals including the New England Journal of Medicine, JAMA, and Health Affairs. He earned his A.B. at Harvard and M.D. and MBA at
