Dr. Coleman is a Research Associate in the Bowles Center for Alcohol Studies at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, NC. He received his M.D. and Ph.D. from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. His Ph.D. work focused on investigating the persistent effects of adolescent and prenatal ethanol exposure on adult brain structure and behavior. Dr. Coleman has authored multiple publications in the field of alcohol addiction. He currently studies the central and systemic immune responses to ethanol, and is attempting to identify novel therapeutic targets for alcohol addiction as well as the associated systemic complications of alcohol use disorders. His clinical interests involve acute critical care and sepsis. He is a member of several professional societies, including the Society for Neuroscience and the Research Society on Alcoholism.
