

Nicholas Gilpin, Ph.D.



Dr. Gilpin is an Associate Professor of Physiology at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center (LSUHSC), as well as Associate Director of the LSUHSC Alcohol & Drug Abuse Center of Excellence (ADACE). Dr. Gilpin received his Ph.D. in Psychology from Purdue University and completed his post-doctoral work under the mentorship of Drs. George Koob and Marisa Roberto at The Scripps Research Institute. Dr. Gilpin is a member of the Neurotoxicology & Alcohol (NAL) study section at the Center for Scientific Review (CSR), and he is a member of the Research Society on Alcoholism (RSA) Board of Directors. Dr. Gilpin's lab conducts research aimed at understanding the neurobiology underlying

interactions between alcohol use disorder (AUD), traumatic stress reactivity, and pain-related outcomes. His lab is funded by an R01 from NIAAA and a V.A. Merit Award. Earlier this year, Dr. Gilpin received the Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists & Engineers (PECASE) from the White House Office of Science & Technology.
