Dr. Berke is the Rudi Schmid Distinguished Professor in the Departments of Neurology and Psychiatry at the University of California, San Francisco. He received his BA/MA from Cambridge University and his Ph.D. in Neurobiology from Harvard. Research in his laboratory examines neural mechanisms underlying decision-making, learning from rewards and motivation, with a particular focus on basal ganglia circuits their modulation by dopamine. At UCSF he is Director of the Wheeler Center for the Neurobiology of Addiction and Division Chief for the Alcohol and Addiction Research Group.
