

Sophia Frangou, M.D., Ph.D.



Dr. Frangou trained at Maudsley and Bethlem Royal Hospitals in London, UK and obtained her PhD from the University of London. She is a Chair in Brain Health at the Department of Psychiatry, University of British Columbia and Professor of Psychiatry at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. She previously held the post of Reader in Psychiatry at the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology and Neuroscience at King's College London, UK. She is editor-in-chief of *European Psychiatry*, the journal of the European Psychiatric Association, and associate editor of *Human Brain Mapping* and *BJPsych Open*. Dr.

Frangou has published over 250 articles focused on elucidating brain-behavior-environment associations in patients with mood and psychotic disorders and in general populations samples. She has received numerous awards including the 2019 Colvin Prize for Outstanding Achievement in Mood Disorders Research from the Brain and Behavior Research Foundation and the 2020 Educator Award from the Society of Biological Psychiatry.
