Dr. David Reiner is a postdoctoral fellow in the laboratory of Dr. Yavin Shaham in the Behavioral Neuroscience Research Branch at the National Institute on Drug Abuse Intramural Research Program (NIDA IRP) in Baltimore, MD. He received his Ph.D. in Neuroscience from the University of Pennsylvania, where he studied the neuroendocrinology of feeding behavior. He currently studies cortical mechanisms of fentanyl relapse after voluntary abstinence in rats and has published in *Journal of Neuroscience*, *Neuropsychopharmacology*, and *Psychopharmacology*. Dr. Reiner has received an F31 pre-doctoral NRSA and the highly competitive Postdoctoral Research Associate Training (PRAT) fellowship (IRP equivalent of F32 post-doctoral NRSA).
