Homelessness and Drug Use

- 2-5 million homeless youth in US (not rare); expect COVID boost
- Overdose deaths increased 200% since 2000 (Rudd, 2016)
- Opioid epidemic disproportionately affected homeless youth; 79% report opioid use (Brands, 2005)




Housing and Prevention

- Prevention focus on family, school or center-based —all difficult for homeless
- Odds of recent hard drug use among homeless HIV positive 4x times higher when remaining homeless (Aidala, 2005)
- Those who obtained housing were 1/2 as likely to use hard drugs and needles, to share needles, and engage in unprotected sex

Recovery Orientation




Efficacy of Housing First

- Meta analysis of four best trials (Baxter, 2019)
- Samples (homeless + HIV, MH, or chronic)
- Outcomes
 - Reduced ED
 - Reduced hospital
 - Increased days housed
 - Increased housing at 18 months (2.4 x)
 - Inadequate measures of drug use
