Dr. Joshua M. Sharfstein is Director of the Bloomberg American Health Initiative, Vice Dean for Public Health Practice and Community Engagement, and Professor of the Practice in Health Policy and Management at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.

Previously, Dr. Sharfstein served as Secretary of the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, as Principal Deputy Commissioner of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, and as Commissioner of Health for Baltimore City. From July 2001 to December 2005, he served as professional staff and health policy advisor for Congressman Henry A. Waxman. He is an elected member of the National Academy of Medicine and the National Academy of Public Administration.

Dr. Sharfstein teaches a class called "Crisis and Response in Public Health Policy and Practice" and is the author of the *Public Health Crisis Survival Guide: Leadership and Management in Trying Times* (2018). He is also the co-author of the book, *The Opioid Epidemic: What Everyone Needs to Know* (2019). Both books are from Oxford University Press.
